Welcome to Firth Close

Firth Close is a detached bungalow where people will feel welcome and supported.

This three-bedroom property has a kitchen, lounge area and dining room. There is a shared bathroom, and one en suite bathroom. Firth Close also has an accessible garden with a patio for people to relax in when the weather is good.

Life at Firth Close is suitable for people with brain injuries, learning or neurological disabilities, physical disabilities or people living with autistic spectrum disorders.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door. There's peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling lives, surrounded by like-minded people.

At Firth Close, people enjoy watching television, socialising, computer games, shopping, playing pool, lying-in in the morning, listening to music, walking, playing the keyboard, and being in the community.

Valued in your community

There is nothing more valuable than being an active part of the local community.

At Firth Close, we are fortunate to be located in a peaceful residential area close to Arnold. The local area has cafés, pubs and restaurants, high-street banks, a post office and a library.

For people who like to stay active, Arnold Leisure Centre provides year-round access to a gym and swimming pool, or there's Hobuck's Nature Reserve for walking when the weather is good.

Nottingham is the nearest city, and offers larger shops and amenities, Cineworld cinema, Nottingham Tenpin Bowl, Nottingham Castle, Museum and Art Gallery, Green's Windmill and Science Centre, ice skating at Motorpoint Arena, Nottingham Playhouse Theatre, and Victoria and Broadmarsh shopping centres.

Nottingham also has Nottingham University City Hospital which provides access to services for brain injury, cystic fibrosis, epilepsy and seizure disorders, speech and language therapy, and neurological rehabilitation outpatients.
