Welcome to Wetherby Close

At Wetherby Close people are supported to live independently.

This four-bedroom detached bungalow has a kitchen, an open-plan living room and dining room, and a laundry room. There are two bathrooms - one with a bath and one wet room style with a shower.

Wetherby Close also has a garden with a patio and wooden decking for people to relax in when the weather is good.

Assistive technology can be tailored to suit each person's needs and includes ceiling hoists in the bathroom, and ramps at the front and back of the property for wheelchair access.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, in your own home. There's peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand whenever they're needed, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling, independent lives, surrounded by like-minded people.

Life at Wetherby Close is suitable for people with learning disabilities, brain injuries, physical disabilities, and autism.

We are ready to welcome a man aged over 40 to join the people we support here, who are aged between 51 and 63 and live with learning disabilities, diabetes and epilepsy.

One person enjoys going to the theatre and the cinema, driving his car, shopping, chatting with staff and going on holiday. Another likes sensory toys and blocks and the third person here enjoys walking and being out of the house.

People choose how they want to spend their time - day trips to Stoke and other local towns are favourites. We have even been on an all-inclusive ABBA-themed weekend in Blackpool.

There is nothing more rewarding than being an active part of the local community.

Wetherby Close is in a peaceful residential area with a restaurant, a newsagent and a post office. Neighbouring Syston has shops, restaurants, pubs, cafés and a library.

For people who like to stay active, the surrounding areas have a range of venues offering exercise classes, sports halls, swimming pools and gyms. People also enjoy walking in the local area - Beedles Lake is a popular destination.
