There are eight one-bedroom apartments, each with an open-plan kitchen and living room, and a wet room style bathroom. Alexandra Road also has a communal area for people to socialise, and an accessible garden with a BBQ for spending time outdoors when the weather is good.

Assistive technology can be tailored to suit the needs of each person and includes an intercom alarm system and CCTV throughout to provide you peace of mind. The property has a lift for internal access to upper floors.

Alexandra Road supports adults with learning disabilities, autism, acquired brain injury and other complex needs within spacious purpose-built apartments.

London is easily accessible from the property and offers attractions including museums, theatres, cinemas, bowling alleys, boat trips on the Thames, the Tower of London, Westminster Abbey, St Paul's Cathedral, Buckingham Palace, ZSL London Zoo, Kensington Palace, Sealife London aquarium, the Shard and the London Eye.
