The bungalow is fully accessible and has three bedrooms, a kitchen, a dining room, a living room, and two bathrooms.

There is an accessible garden for people to use when the weather is good.

Valued in your community

There is nothing more valuable than being an active part of the local community.

Green Lane is in Hove Edge, which has shops, pubs, and takeaways. We also have easy access to surrounding villages for larger amenities. Neighbouring Brighouse provides access to larger high-street shops and banks, as well as a post office and a library.

For people who like to stay active, Brighouse Swimming Pool and Fitness Centre has exercise classes, sports courts, a gym and a swimming pool.

Halifax is the nearest large town and offers a Vue Cinema, Halifax Playhouse and Victoria Theatre, The Eureka! Science Museum, Calderdale Industrial Museum, Woolshops Shopping Centre, and Electric Bowl for bowling.

People also like to visit Huddersfield for attractions including Kingsgate and Packhorse Shopping Centres, Lawrence Batley Theatre, high-street banks and an Odeon Cinema.
