Oaks Lane also has an accessible garden with a patio for people to enjoy when the weather is good.

At Oaks Lane, people choose how they spend their time. Trips to the coast and tourist attractions are favourites. People have hobbies including cooking, gaming, listening to music, walking, going out for lunch, gardening, shopping, socialising and being in the community.
