#### At St Lukes people are supported to live with independence.

This three-bedroom semi-detached house has a kitchen, a dining room, a living room, and one communal bathroom which has a bath with a hoist. St Lukes also has a garden for people to enjoy when the weather is good.

Assistive technology can be tailored to suit the needs of each person. There is a lift to access the upper floor and all doors are wider to enable wheelchair access.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door. There's peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling lives, surrounded by like-minded people.



Life at St Lukes is suitable for people with learning or neurological disabilities, brain injuries and physical disabilities.

St Lukes is in the community of Little Horton, which has shops, pubs, cafés, restaurants and a post office. For people who like to stay active, Bradford has a range of venues with exercise classes, sports courts, gyms and swimming pools.

Bradford city centre is a short distance away by transport, and is within walking distance and provides access to The Broadway Bradford and Kirkgate shopping centres, the National Science and Media Museum, a Cineworld Cinema, Bradford Ice Arena for ice skating and the Alhambra Theatre.

People also like to visit Halifax which offers a Vue Cinema, Halifax Playhouse and Victoria Theatre, The Eureka! Science Museum, Calderdale Industrial Museum, Woolshops Shopping Centre, and Electric Bowl for bowling.

We're in Little Horton. Bradford is just a thirty-minute walk, while Halifax is about twenty minutes away by car.



There's a Lidl within walking distance, while Asda and Tesco are a little further away.



The GP surgery and NHS dentist are within half a mile of the property.



There's a bus stop within a short walk, with routes into Bradford and Buttershaw.



The train station is just a four-minute drive, and has services to Leeds, Huddersfield, Blackpool, Preston, Manchester and London.



There is on-site parking for people with cars.
