At Marble Court apartments, people benefit from living in a vibrant network of staff and friends, while enjoying the peace and quiet of their own space when they need it too.

Marble Court is a set of nine apartments, each with one bedroom, a kitchen, a living room and a dining room. Some bathrooms have a shower while others have a bath.

Marble Court also has an accessible garden with a BBQ for spending time outdoors when the weather is pleasant. There is level access on the ground floor only. Pets may be allowed.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door.

Life at Marble Court is suitable for people with learning disabilities, physical disabilities, mental health conditions, brain injuries and autism.

Marble Court is in a residential area with shops, pubs, restaurants, a library and a post office. Blackburn is the nearest town and offers the Empire Theatre, museums and art galleries, a Vue cinema, Planet Ice for skating, the Mall Shopping Centre and Market, Tenpin Blackburn for bowling, and many historical landmarks.

Blackburn also provides access to the Royal Blackburn Hospital which has specialist services for adult mental illness, stroke, dementia, and occupational therapy.

For people who like to stay active, Blackburn has a range of leisure centres for exercise classes, sports courts, swimming pools and gyms.
