At Spencefield Gardens people are welcomed and supported to live independent lives.

This five-bedroom detached property has a kitchen, living room, laundry room, and study. There is one bathroom upstairs with a bath and shower, one bathroom downstairs with a shower, and two ensembles - one with a shower, and the other with a bath and shower.

Spencefield Gardens also has an accessible garden for people to relax in when the weather is good.

Spencefield Gardens is ready to welcome someone new. There are currently two two male residents, who live with mental health conditions and Autism.

People also enjoy watching television, shopping, gardening, swimming, listening to music, walking, and being in the community. Day trips to Skegness and to the zoo are favourites.

Valued in your community

There are few things more rewarding than feeling like an active and valued part of the community.

Spencefield Gardens is in a peaceful residential area close to Evington. The area has cafes and pubs, as well as nice walks in the local parks.

For people who like to stay active, Evington Leisure Centre provides year-round access to exercise classes, two swimming pools and a gym.

Nearby Leicester offers larger attractions, such as Leicester Castle, Haymarket or Highcross shopping centres, a Phoenix Cinema and Art Centre, an Odeon Cinema, East Street Lanes for bowling, and the Curve Theatre. There are also museums including the National Space Centre and the Guildhall Museum, as well as restaurants and high-street banks.


