## Welcome to Abbeymoor

Abbeymoor, on the outskirts of Gateshead in Tyne and Wear, is a specialist residential neurological care centre providing longterm person-centred care and support for adults with either a brain injury or complex neurological condition, with particular expertise in the management of Huntington's Disease.

There are 40 bedrooms at the service, many of them en-suite. There are communal areas including a games room, large conservatory and a relaxation and therapy room. There's an on-site laundry service, access to a minibus and an extensive activities programme with something for everyone.

Outside there are lovely private gardens with patio areas for everyone to enjoy.

The people we support here benefit from the services of a physiotherapist who visits the service on a weekly basis and works with individuals, tailoring their programme to ensure they reach their maximum potential.

Abbeymoor is a specialist centre providing long term person-centred care and support for individuals who have complex problems associated with either a brain injury or other neurological conditions. We support people with a range of neurological conditions, including Acquired Brain Injury, Huntington's Disease, Motor Neurone Disease and Spinal Injury. We work alongside health professionals to give each resident the highest standards of support.
