**Tynwald Hill is a development of six apartments, where people are supported to live happy and independent lives.**

Each apartment has a spacious bedroom, kitchen, living room and a bathroom with a shower. On the ground floor there's a shared living room area with a television where residents can socialise and relax. Outside there's a large, shared garden with a lawn and patio area.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door. There's peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling lives, surrounded by like-minded people.



Life at Tynwald Hill is suitable for people with mental health conditions, brain injuries or physical disabilities.

The current residents have lived here for over five years. This service is ideal for someone relatively independent who would like to live in the community, but with the reassurance that staff are available whenever they need support or assistance.

People living at Tynwald Hill enjoy walking, cooking, listening to music, socialising and being in the community. People choose how they spend their time – trips to the coast are a favourite. As a group, people also enjoy going on an annual caravan holiday together.
