Welcome to Cranhurst Road


Cranhurst Road is a newly refurbished house in a great North London location. The house has six bedrooms, all with their own en-suite wet room.

The house is spacious and has two kitchens, laundry rooms, two shared bathrooms with baths and two downstairs toilets. There are two large living rooms with French doors opening onto the south-facing gardens. There's also a staff office for waking night support.

The garden is large, laid to lawn with a beautiful tree and patio area.
