Welcome to Scholes Croft

At Scholes Croft apartments, people come together as a community.

Living in this shared building means people benefit from a vibrant network of staff and friends, as well as enjoying peace and quiet when they need it too.

There are sixteen one-bedroom apartments, each with an open-plan kitchen and living room, and a wet room style bathroom. Scholes Croft also has an accessible garden with a patio and a BBQ where people can relax when the weather is good. Pets may be allowed as there are two resident cats.

Assistive technology includes a Tunstall system, an intercom and CCTV throughout. The apartments are wheelchair accessible and have extra wide doors. There is a lift to access the second floor.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door. There's peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling lives, surrounded by like-minded people.

Life at Scholes Croft is suitable for people with learning disabilities, brain injuries, physical disabilities, mental health conditions, and autistic spectrum disorders.

At Scholes Croft, people choose how they spend their time. Day trips to Blackpool and the coast are favourites.

At Scholes Croft, the local area has pubs, takeaways, parks, shops and a library.

For people who like to stay active, Queens Park Health and Fitness provides year-round access to a gym and swimming pool, or people can enjoy walking in Thatto Heath Park.

Nearby St Helens offers a range of larger amenities including a Cineworld Cinema, St Helen's Theatre Royal, North West Museum of Road Transport, and Church Square Shopping Centre.

Warrington is easily accessible from the property, and offers attractions including the Pyramid art centre, Golden Square Shopping Centre, Superbowl UK for bowling, and an Odeon Luxe cinema.

For supermarkets, Londis is close by, and Morrisons, Asda, Lidl, Aldi and Iceland are all in St Helens.
