Life at Riverswey is suitable for people with learning disabilities, physical disabilities and autism.

The small size of Riverswey contributes to an intimate homely feel in which individuals have the benefit of 24-hour support from our trained team, while still having the freedom to live life in the way they want.

Services are offered to people with learning disabilities, complex needs including autism and behaviours that challenge, and mental health.

We work closely with each individual and families to develop a personalised care plan which helps people work towards achieving life goals.
