Welcome to Lightwood Road

Lightwood Road is a welcoming, supportive and stimulating residential service for people with complex care and support needs to live fulfilling lives.

The property has a kitchen, lounge area, dining room and laundry room. There are two toilets and two shared bathrooms – one with a shower and a bath, the other with a shower. There is also an accessible garden with a patio.

Assistive technology is fitted throughout to give you peace of mind. This includes an intercom, an Assi Tech Pager System and a nurse alarm call system.

Life at Lightwood Road is suitable for people with brain injuries, learning or neurological disabilities, mental health conditions, physical disabilities, or autistic spectrum disorders.

Lightwood Road is ideal for an active and sociable person. At Lightwood Road, we currently support both men and women with diverse needs, including learning disabilities, brain injuries and physical disabilities.

People enjoy sitting in the garden, sensory activities, shopping, singing, music therapy, karaoke, football, listening to music, watching television, shopping, bowling, bingo and being in the community.



Lightwood Road is an active household – people choose how they spend their time. We go on regular day trips - Chester Zoo, or the monkey forest at Trentham Gardens are favourites. People here like to stay in a specialised hotel in Blackpool, and every year people choose to watch the local Christmas pantomime.

A short bus journey will take you to Stoke-on-Trent, which has larger attractions including Waterworld swimming pool, Festival Retail Park and intu Potteries for shopping, Regent Theatre, the Potteries Museum and Art Gallery, Tenpin Stoke bowling, an Odeon Cinema and a Cineworld.
