The shared bungalow at Cartbridge Lane offers people independent living in a supported environment.

There are two rooms and one shared bathroom, which functions as a wet room. The property also has a communal kitchen and a living room. There's also a garden for everyone to enjoy.

There is also the New Art Gallery, Lichfield Street Hub Library, The Light Cinema, and the Walsall Gala Baths for swimming and other leisure activities.

The local area has a park with an outdoor gym, basic shops and a McDonald's. At Cartbridge Lane, people choose how they want to spend their time - we often take day trips to Weston Super Mare and enjoy eating out together or going to the pub.
