Welcome to Trent View

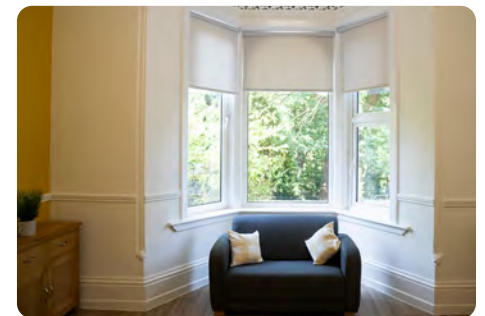
Trent View is a welcoming, supportive and stimulating residential service for people with complex care and support needs to live fulfilling lives.

Recently refurbished to a high standard, the service provides a flexible and comfortable living environment that can support nine people, with ample space across two comfortable lounges, a sunny kitchen, a dining room, and a sensory / activities room. Each of the nine bedrooms features an en-suite bathroom ensuring comfort and privacy. Outside there is an enclosed private garden offering a peaceful area for everyone to enjoy.

Life at Trent View is well suited to individuals with learning difficulties, mental health conditions, or people living on the autistic spectrum.

Trent View would be ideal for an able-bodied, sociable person aged between 30 and 50 with learning disabilities.

All of the people we support like to spend time in the community. One works one day a week in the local area.

Leisure activities include Coopers Square Shopping Centre, a Cineworld Cinema, Trent View indoor market and Mecca Bingo.
