Trent View is a specialist residential service for nine adults, who are autistic or living with complex needs including learning disabilities, autism, mental ill-health, sensory impairment, or eating disorders. Recently refurbished to a high standard, the service provides a flexible and comfortable living environment that can support nine people, with ample space across two comfortable lounges, a sunny kitchen, a dining room, and a sensory / activities room. Each bedroom features an en-suite bathroom ensuring comfort and privacy. Outside there is an enclosed private garden offering a peaceful area for everyone to enjoy.

## Meet the team:

We're proud of our highly skilled and dedicated team, who work closely with families, social workers, GP's and other professionals to deliver the highest standard of care and support. As well as a thorough induction, every team member undergoes specialised training unique to the needs of each person we support. This includes Dysphagia, Epilepsy, Anaphylaxis, Food Hygiene, NAPPI, and Autism. We also work closely with our own Positive Behaviour Support team to ensure we provide compassionate support to enable people to lead meaningful lives without unnecessary restrictions.

### **Our location:**
