Cherry Trees is a modern DORMA bungalow where people are supported to live happy and independent lives.

The house features five bedrooms, one of which is used as a sleep-in room for overnight support. Four of the bedrooms are downstairs with one upstairs. There’s a large lounge at the front of the house, an open plan kitchen and dining room and a separate utility room.

There’s a wet room style bathroom upstairs and a shared ground floor bathroom with a bath. The lower level of the house is wheelchair accessible. Outside there’s a large back garden with a lawn and a patio area that everyone can enjoy.

When you choose supported living, you’re choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door. There’s peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling lives, surrounded by like-minded people.



Life at Cherry Trees is suitable for people with learning disabilities or autism. There are four ladies living here, aged between 35 and 60. They enjoy doing things together, going out for meals, trips to the theatre and shopping. The atmosphere at the home is very homely, the people who live here are encouraged to do as much for themselves as possible. They always have home cooked meals and love cooking for each other.
