Welcome to Savery Gardens

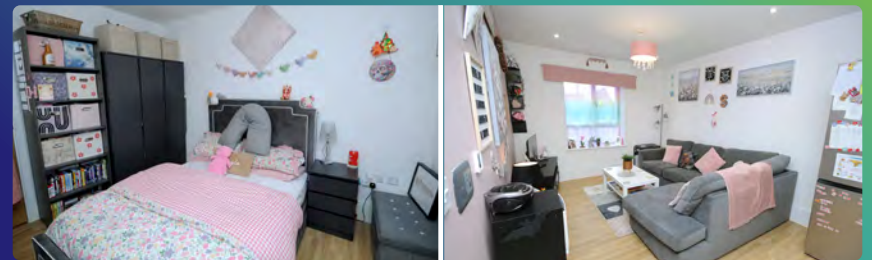
Savery Gardens is a modern, beautifully finished property where people are supported to live independently.

This set of apartments provides the perfect mix of independent living and staff support – living in a shared building means individuals can benefit from a vibrant community, while having peace and quiet whenever they need it too.

The property has 18 one-bedroom apartments arranged over 3 floors. There are also 2 accessible one-bedroom bungalows. Each apartment and bungalow has an open plan kitchen and living room, hallway, bedroom and wet room. There's also a communal area and a shared garden for everyone to enjoy.

Every apartment is equipped with an intercom system, and the property has CCTV. Assistive technology within each apartment can be tailored to suit individual needs. There's even a large shed that can be used for mobility scooters.

When you choose supported living, you're choosing to live independently, safe and secure behind your own front door. There's peace of mind in knowing the Lifeways team is on-hand, providing tailored support that helps people to lead more fulfilling lives, surrounded by like-minded people.

Transport links are excellent – the bus stop is metres from the service and from there you can get to Dudley, Birmingham and Wolverhampton. Tipton train station is less than a mile away, with connections to Birmingham New Street, Wolverhampton and beyond.

For people who like to stay active, there's a local leisure centre and a choice of gyms, plus some amazing outdoor spaces to explore – Victoria Park and Wrensnest Nature Reserve are both within walking distance.
