Welcome to Beeton Grange

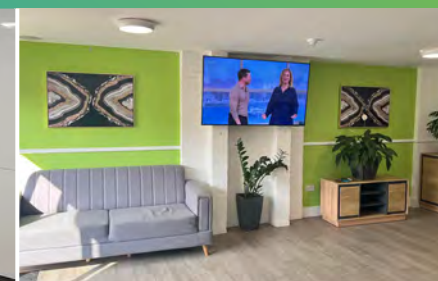
Beeton Grange is a residential service providing specialist recovery support for adults.
