Elm Tree House is located in Norden, Rochdale and benefits from excellent transport links to Bury, Rochdale and Manchester. It offers year round opportunities for the people we support to engage with our team, each other and the wider community.

Our property features six bedrooms with ensuite facilities plus one shared bathroom on each floor. The ground floor is wheelchair accessible. The home also includes two kitchens, two dining rooms, two living rooms and a large garden for socialising.

The layout is designed to support both independence and community living, giving residents the freedom to choose how they spend their day while ensuring there are always welcoming shared spaces available. Outside, the garden provides a relaxed, open space for social activities or simply sitting quietly and enjoying the fresh air.

This includes NAPPI, seizure management, autism spectrum support, mental health support and Positive Behaviour Support (PBS), delivered in partnership with our Specialist Support Team.

Elm Tree House is home to a diverse group of adults, who are currently male, each with their own needs, preferences and personal goals. Some individuals may at times display behaviours that challenge, and we work in a person-centred way to help them build confidence, develop new skills and feel empowered in their daily lives.

At Elm Tree House, we support LT, originally from Poland, who had been unable to visit family for many years due to complex visa and passport issues.

Being separated from his loved ones for such a long time had a significant impact on both him and his family. Our team worked closely with the relevant authorities to successfully resolve these issues and supported him to plan a trip to Poland, with two staff members accompanying him.

LT has now returned to Poland twice in the last three years, helping him reconnect with family and his cultural roots. This has had a hugely positive impact on his emotional wellbeing, confidence and quality of life. It was a great success and a positive experience for LT and his family and we are proud to have helped make it possible.

Elm Tree House is a spacious, welcoming home that offers plenty of opportunities for people to spend time together or enjoy quiet moments alone, depending on their preference. Our extensive grounds are ideal for games, picnics or simply relaxing outdoors.
